Cybersecurity Analytic Center

The Cybersecurity Analytic Center (CAC) at Howard University has made significant strides in academic excellence, industry engagement, and student enrichment over the past year. With 57 students competing in the National Cyber League (NCL), Howard ranked in the top 95% nationally, showing a 76% improvement from the previous year. Graduates have secured roles at top firms such as Bank of America, Deloitte, and PwC, while others gained global experience through study abroad programs in Paris. Students have participated in major conferences, visited leading tech companies, and benefited from guest lectures by industry experts. Enrichment programs awarded over \$72,000 in scholarships, supported student clubs, hosted workshops with 600+ attendees, and launched major initiatives like the Google Cybersecurity Clinic and the DOD Cyber Service Academy.
